Family Support

Our experienced, friendly practitioners work alongside families and individuals in flexible ways to deliver skilled interventions that are focused and time-limited. Support for families can include help with how child development impacts behaviour, as well as exploring strategies, tools, and techniques to help families meet their challenges.

Our practitioners also help families through the maze of emotions experienced by parents of children with additional needs. We can help them access specialist services, liaise with schools regarding changes that may need to be made, and provide support in navigating the diagnosis process and statutory assessments.

Befriending

Our befrienders support people by regularly visiting, or calling. They help people experiencing loneliness or isolation, for a variety of reasons. We also encourage people to attend our weekly groups to make new friendships.

We work alongside Devon Carers providing 'Time For You', a sitting-in service giving unpaid carers much-needed respite, safe in the knowledge their loved one is being cared for.



Music Centre

Okehampton Music Centre encourages young people to get more involved with music. We aim to make learning an instrument affordable for all and to develop players so that our local, regional, and national ensembles thrive in the future.

We believe that children's musical journeys should start as early as possible and have classes for children aged 3 to 18.

Junior Music Centre

Monday's (term time) - A30 Business Centre, Higher Stockley Mead.

Age 3 - 4 years (Preschool and reception) 4:00pm to 4:30pm
